

May 2011 Service Changes

Weekdays: The first three departures from the Transit Center will remain at 6:20 a.m., 6:50 a.m. and 7:20 a.m. After 7:20 a.m., trips will depart the Transit Center every 35 minutes until 5:50 p.m. After 5:50 p.m., trips will leave the Transit Center at 6:40 p.m. and every 70 minutes until 11:20 p.m. Midday routes that currently operate hourly will instead operate every 70 minutes to maintain transfer connections.

Routes 20, 23, 26 and 28 are not affected by the changes at this time.

Saturdays: The first four departures from the Transit Center will remain at 6:20 a.m., 7:20 a.m., 8:20 a.m. and 9:20 a.m. After 9:20 a.m., buses will depart the Transit Center at 10:30 a.m. and every 35 or 70 minutes until 5:30 p.m., then at 6:40 p.m. and every 70 minutes until 11:20 p.m.

Sundays: Departures from the Transit Center will be unchanged, although time points along some routes may change slightly.

Route-specific details:

Route 6 – All trips will operate over Hollow Creek, LaSalle and Asbury all day in both directions weekdays and Saturdays. This is to help alleviate confusion about which way the bus is going and will save passengers time by not having to board a bus going the ‘wrong’ direction in order to get where they are going.

Route 8 – All trips to and from Fayette Mall will operate over Clays Mill Road to Keithshire Way both inbound and outbound.

Route 10 – All trips weekdays and Saturdays will now operate the full route inbound and outbound over Liberty Road and Fortune Way. *Sunday service will continue to operate outbound Liberty Road – Fortune Way and inbound direct via Winchester Road due to time constraints.*

Route 11 – All trips will operate via St. Michael and St. Ann (Idle Hour Loop) both inbound and outbound all days. Late night combo trips operated by Route 1 will not operate through Idle Hour area.

Route 12 – Inbound trips will revert to operating Red Mile/Virginia to Limestone Street to the Transit Center on all days. A new schedule timepoint has been established on Leestown Road at Taylor Drive.

Route 13 – Late-night trips operated by Route 8 will now continue to/from Palomar Center at Man ‘O War Blvd. and Harrodsburg Road. These trips previously ended at Beaumont Center, and will no longer do so. Board these trips on Harrodsburg Road.

Route 16 – All trips will serve BCTC Cooper both inbound and outbound. This provides a connection between the south campus and the Cooper campus at all times.

Route 18 – All trips will operate via full route via Buckhorn Drive in both directions. This will eliminate the large one-way loop that forces passengers to “ride around” to get from the Buckhorn Drive area to or from any other location on the route.

Route 19 – This route will be discontinued due to very low ridership.
